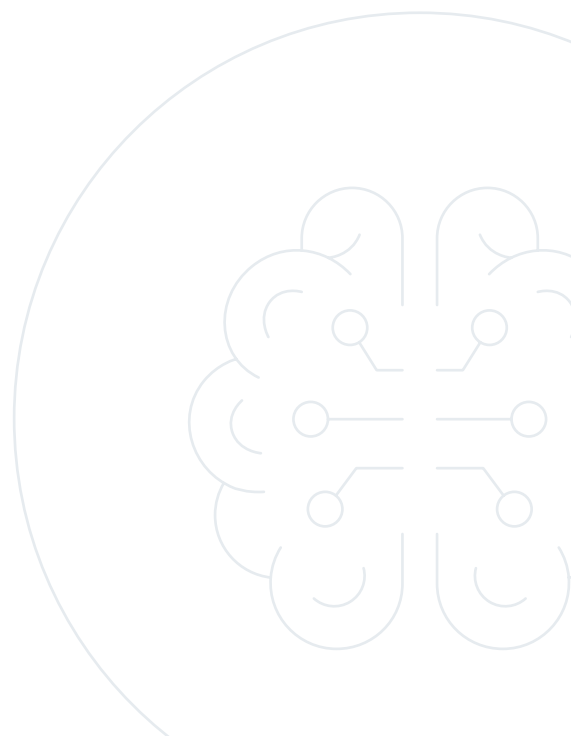

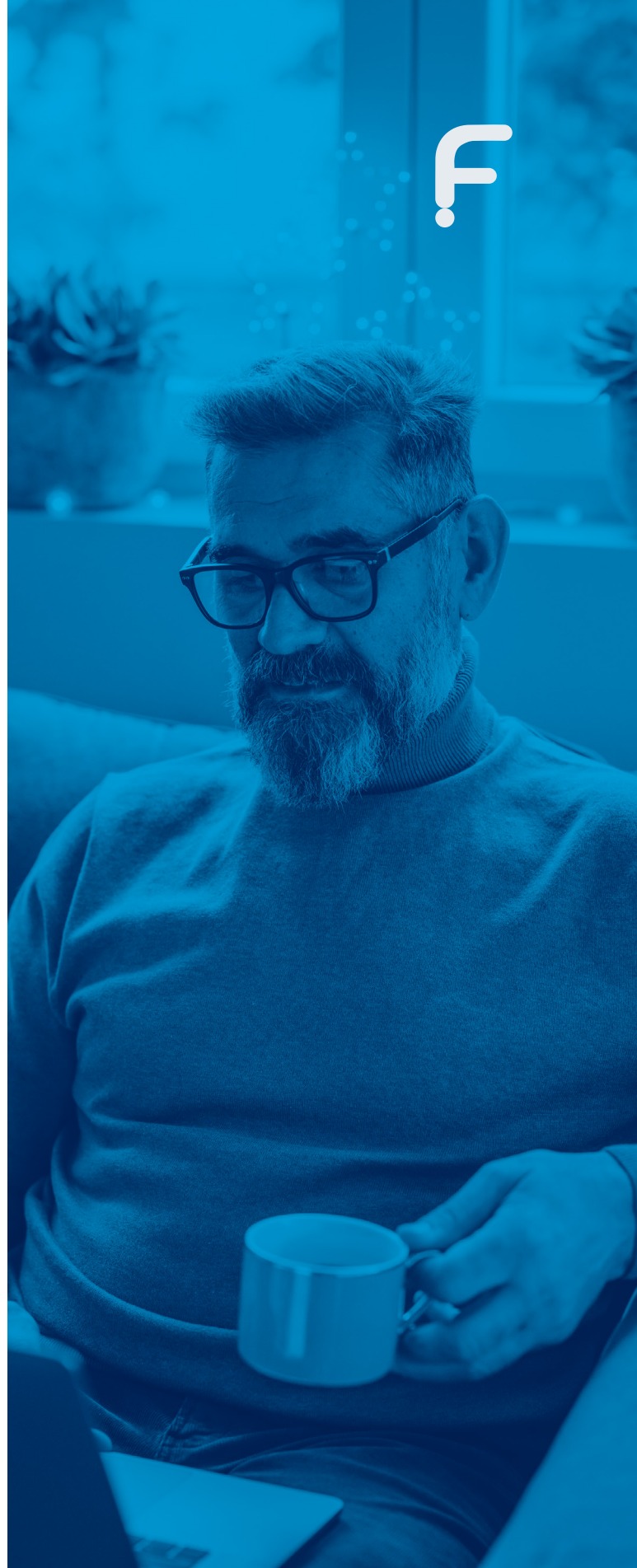

Summary in Word

Copilot can then use the Excel data to generate a summary or report in a Word document. For example, you could ask Copilot to "Write a sales report summarising the Q1 numbers by region" and it will create a well-formatted report pulling the relevant figures and creating readable analysis in written form.

Presentation in PowerPoint

And if you want to transform that report into a stylish slide deck based on your Word document, Copilot can automatically generate a proposed outline structure for a PowerPoint deck. By analysing headings, topic sentences, and content organisation, it produces a logical slide sequence covering the key points.

Copilot can then generate the actual PowerPoint slides, intelligently pulling through relevant sections of text and multimedia content. In addition, Copilot can generate presenter notes or narrative script drawing from the more detailed explanations and context in the Word document. And if the document contains data or insights, Copilot can automatically transform those into designed data visualisations such as charts, graphs and diagrams.

Including Source Details

The summary will provide key context like which individuals were involved in particular parts of the discussion. It can also embed or link to the original source conversations/documents for easy reference.

Tailoring Summaries

Copilot can tailor the summary's depth, tone, and framing based on the intended audience or situation. For example, providing a high-level executive brief versus a detailed recap for a status meeting.

By consolidating knowledge scattered across multiple Microsoft 365 applications and sources into cohesive narratives, Copilot eliminates the duplicative work of manually tracking down and reconciling information.
