


Over time, patching cabinets become messy, to the point where they look like spaghetti; cooling fans become masked; routing becomes ill-defined; moves adds and changes (MACs) become cumbersome. Problems quietly build and the likelihood of a cabling mistake or outage increases.

To overcome this, our experienced technicians have provided comms room support services for over 20 years to some of the UK's most respected brands.

We audit the patching system, re-shuffle cabinets and panels, install trunking and/or cable trays, install coloured cables with a unique ID and re-patch in an orderly configuration.

To minimise disruption we can complete our work outside of normal office hours and typically average more than 3,000 hours annually supporting in-house IT teams outside of 9-5. Once complete, we leave you with a clear cabling plan.

Comms Room Services

SAS provides three options to support your comms room: we can design, project-manage and install your own on-premise solution; or we can relocate your servers and hardware to our next-generation data centre; or we can provide a bit of both by using our DC as part of your disaster recovery planning. We provide flexible solutions from 1/4, 1/2 to full racks (with no minimum contract period) right through to private suites.

A14 Integrated Delivery Team



As part of a £1bn+ project to extend and improve the A14 between Cambridge and Huntingdon, the A14 integrated delivery team needed to establish a fixed line and mobile infrastructure along a 31km stretch of greenfield land. A key objective was to deliver secure access to cloud-based applications for 650 users alongside secure access to several corporate networks (bring your own corporate device, BYOCD).

- Secure, agile BYOCD network design, allowing corporate network access for each major partner, plus open access for local and cloud services and roaming between sites
- Internet connectivity for A14 user-base and access into a backbone network
- Cloud-based perimeter security for network and users
- SAS Network In Advance: collaborative provisioning, costing and delivery planning using their Infrastructure Readiness services.
- Bonded, multi-carrier 4G WAN connectivity with high gain external antennae for increased reliability and performance
- Line of Sight (LoS) connections (between main sites and smaller units)
- Gigabit BT fibre links (for main sites)

- On-site cabinets, cabling, LAN and Wi-Fi infrastructure
- Project and provisioning management, engineering and installation services
- 24/7 monitoring through the SAS UK-based NOC






